

Minnesota Jaycees Supershot 2002

COMPETITION RULES

1. Each participant will complete, in his or her grade level (grades 4-9), regardless of age, height or weight.
2. Each participant will have 60 seconds to shoot as many times as they can from the seven scoring positions. They **MUST** shoot from every scoring position at least once or be penalized the point value of the position(s) missed.
3. The High School regulation 3-point line is a bonus shooting position worth 7 points. Participants **do not** have to shoot from this position. This bonus position can only be scored from twice in each 60-second attempt. No more than 14 points can be earned from this position in a round.
4. Each participant will have two 60 second attempts to shoot. The highest score, from either of the two attempts, will be the participant's final score for the competition.
5. Tie Breakers: Any participants involved in a tie will shoot one more (60 second) attempt to determine the winner. The person who receives the lower score will receive the next place. (Ex: Joe and Jim are tied for 1st place. Joe receives the higher score in the tie breaker attempt. Joe receives 1st place and Jim will receive 2nd place, 3rd place will be determined after that.)
6. No one may aid the participant in retrieving his or her ball after each shooting attempt.
7. In the event that the participant doesn't shoot from all positions, the points that would have been scored from a particular position will be subtracted from the final score.
EXAMPLE: *If the participant failed to shoot from position #7, which is valued at 4 points, then the scorer must subtract 4 points from their final score of that round.*
8. Boys in grades 4-6, and girls in grades 4-9 will use an official girls varsity basketball. Boys in grades 7-9 will use an official boy's varsity basketball.
9. The participant **MUST** have one of their feet clearly on the numbered floor disk or marker provided by the chapter in order to have the points awarded for that scoring position.

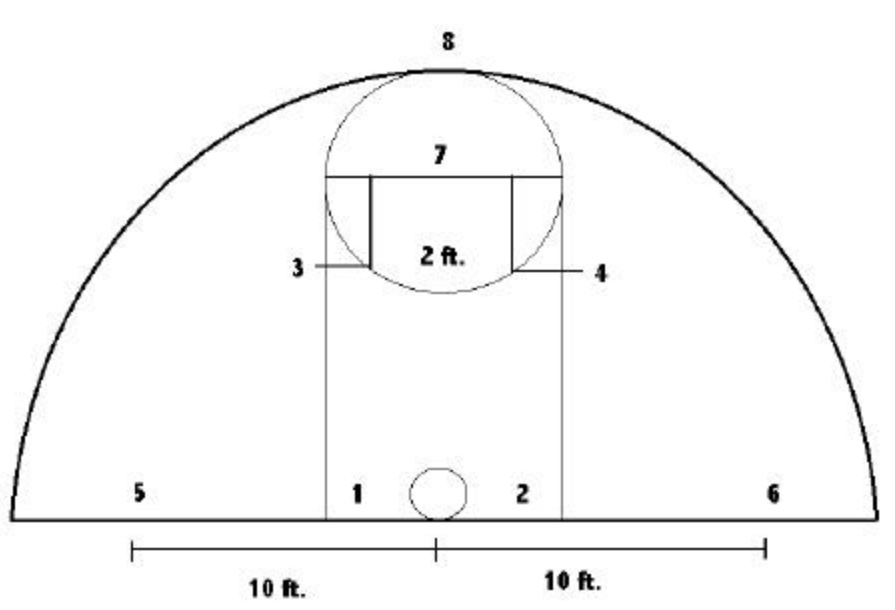
PREPARATION

1. The court area should be set up as described below. Numbered floor disks should be placed on the floor at the appropriate locations (see diagram).
2. Create as many contest courts as you see fit. However, be careful so they don't interfere with each other. Each kit will contain two sets of numbered floor disks to use. * If you use more than two baskets for the competition, then lines should be marked on the floor with a colored tape, such as electrician's tape, that can easily be seen by the participants.
3. Each court should have a scorer and a timer with a stopwatch.

** If court is using tape lines for shooting areas the participant MUST have their foot clearly behind the tape or marker of each shooting area in order to have the points awarded for that scoring position.*

THE SCORING POSITIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Position</u>		
1 & 2.....	Under a basket.....	1 point
3 & 4.....	2 ft. down from FT line.....	2 points
5 & 6.....	Base Line (10 ft.).....	3 points
7.....	Free Throw Line.....	4 points
8.....	OPTIONAL 3 point line.....	7 points
